

6.1.1 The institution's governance reflects and aligns with the vision and mission of the institution.

To fulfil the vision and mission, the college has taken up numerous activities both within and outside the college for a holistic development of the students, the college and the society as a whole. Following are the activities conducted by the college during the academic session 2022-2023:

1. The college took the initiative to felicitate a few famous and dedicated women of Jorhat District on occasion of the Foundation Day of the Women's Cell of CKB Commerce College, AASTHA. The women who were felicitated were Nabanita Das (Organic Farming), Dr. Aditi Bezbaruah (Education), Mallika Rehman (Social Service), Pushpalata Saikia (Ancient Treatment) and Bandita Neog (Cultural).
2. World Environment Day was celebrated by the college on 05.06.2022 with planting and distribution of saplings by the students and teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. Dr. Bobita Sarmah and Dr. Munti Baruah from ASSAM AGRICULTURE UNIVERSITY, Jorhat graced the occasion.
