

Action Taken Report on the feedback 2022-23

CKB Commerce College is pleased to present the Action Taken Report on the feedback received from students, alumni, and faculty regarding the curriculum delivery at CKB Commerce College Jorhat. The Curricular Aspects Committee diligently collected valuable insights, and the following actions have been undertaken to address the concerns and suggestions:

Limited Curriculum Flexibility:

The college, following the university-prescribed curriculum, has inherent limitations in making significant changes.

Field Visits:

Responding to student requests for field visits, a two-day field trip was organized by the Students Support and Progression Committee in collaboration with the Jorhat District Tourist Information Office on June 30th and July 1st, 2023, which included trips to various destinations such as Mudoijan Shri Shri Kamalabari Hakha Satra, Kohargaon, Kumargaon, Mesamari Beel, Triveni Sangam, Gibbon Wildlife Sanctuary, and the Thengal Cultural Centre and Museum.

The program aimed at fostering a deeper understanding of the local environment with the theme 'know your locality.'

NCC, NSS, and other co-curricular activities continue to provide additional field study opportunities, enriching the overall learning experience for the students.

Placement Drives:

In response to alumni suggestions for more placement opportunities, the college has been regularly organizing job fairs within the campus to connect students with potential employers.

Internship Opportunities:

Addressing the need for internship opportunities, the college has adopted the newly drafted National Education Policy (NEP) structure, which emphasizes and facilitates internships as an integral part of the academic curriculum.
